RULES OF THE CLUB

Revised 26th October 2012

(The only change is the rewording of Rule 8, to conform with the change in the Constitution made in April 2011.)

1. Members only:

Subscriptions are payable immediately on acceptance, and thereafter at the start of each Club new year. Membership lapses if the subscription is not paid by a date determined by the Committee.

2. All Members are encouraged to be members of British Naturism.

3. All who attend swims and any other naturist functions:

Attendance is open to:

- Club Members
- Members of other naturist clubs providing proof of membership
- Members of British Naturism
- Guests of any of the above
- Visitors interested in naturism, who must bring photographic proof of

identity, for example a driving licence or a passport, and provide their address and telephone numbers

4. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or by a Member of the Club bringing permission in writing from their parent or legal guardian.

5. Attendance is at own risk. The safety and behaviour of guests are the responsibility of their host, and those of children are the responsibility of their parent or guardian.

6. All persons attending must obey any instructions from pool staff.

7. The use of any form of camera is prohibited, and cameras must not be taken into naturist areas. (The only exception to this is the taking of news or publicity photographs by prior agreement of the Committee, and with the agreement of all those appearing thereon.)

8. The Committee reserves the right to suspend or terminate Membership, but the Member must be informed in writing of the reason, and given the opportunity to respond. Members of the Committee may instruct a Visitor to leave the premises at any time.

9. All persons attending are required to follow the naturist code by sitting on a towel at all times and at all places at Cascades, except of course in the pools and jacuzzi.

10. Genital jewellery is not allowed on either men or women.

11. Should anyone have a complaint about the Club that cannot be resolved informally, the complaint should be put in writing to the Committee.

12. Members of the Committee can deal with any matter not covered by the Rules, at their discretion.

13. The aim of these Rules is for everyone to enjoy a relaxed family atmosphere.
